

PROPOSED FACILITY HIGHLIGHTS
GCISD BOND PROGRAM 2005

The following proposals and estimated costs are included in the single-proposition that will be considered by voters during the Bond Election on September 10, 2005.

Technology - \$10,031,250

- Add document repository system (electronic document storage)
- Add digital copier/PDF scanner/fax machine unit (two for administration and 18 for campuses)
- Add network drops in hallways and selected rooms of campuses
- Replace 5,500 computers, including software, over five-year period (80 percent of inventory and includes student, teacher and administrative computers)
- Add uninterruptible power supplies (UPS) for telephone systems (23 locations)
- Add desktop laser printers for elementary classrooms, administrators, and replacements for broken printers
- Add projectors for classrooms (not mounted)
- Add projectors for labs (mounted)
- Add interactive white board for labs
- Complete tech labs at secondary schools with seven remaining modules
- Replace classroom televisions, as needed
- Upgrade video broadcast capabilities for campus broadcasts and district cable feed
- Add laptops for instructional/campus use
- Add wireless accessibility at campuses
